

BEWARE of Email Scammers!!!

In this day and age you can't trust anybody (or at least who they appear to be). More and more people get hacked, have valuable financial information stolen or lose everything on their computers. All with just the simple click of a button or answer to an email.

Always be cautious. If it sounds too good to be true or if the language doesn't sound quite write, don't even answer an email. When you do, you're letting them know that they have a valid email address. Either call the apparent sender to confirm it validity or simply delete it. NEVER click on any blue links in suspicious emails, texts or on websites. They immediately execute a program onto your computer. Even if the email address looks correct, if you hoover your mouse pointer over it, the actual location will be revealed to you.

High tech and high up people everywhere are being affected. Recently a spoofed email appearing to be from the Grand Exalted Ruler was sent out. So be aware, scammers might target our local Lodge as well. Anywhere scammers can find a "pecking" order with a chief officer (they can impersonate) and a list of email addresses form a website or something else, then they'll go after them. So much like locks on our doors and alarm systems, the need to protect ourselves electronically is here. Verify whenever possible. - Scott Stephens
