



Be Recognized for U.S. Flag Display at Home!

Our Americanism chair, Claudia Santos, is looking to recognize our members that display the American flag at their homes. Please send her an email to let her know that you are not only displaying the U.S. flag but doing so properly. Pictures are encouraged as well but not required. Please notify Claudia (cmsantos1209@gmail.com) and receive a certificate for your allegiance.



The U.S.A. flag is a symbol of freedom and liberty to which Americans pledge their allegiance. The flag's 13 alternating red and white stripes represent the 13 original colonies. It's 50 white stars on a blue field represent the 50 states. The colors on the flag represent: Red for valor and bravery; white for purity and innocence; blue for vigilance, perseverance, and justice.

Public Law 93-344 is known as the Federal Flag Code. It contains the rules for handling and displaying the U.S. flag. Traditional guidelines call for displaying the flag in public only from sunrise to sunset. However, the flag may be displayed at all times if it is illuminated during darkness. The flag should not be subject to weather damage, so it should not be displayed during rain, snow and wind storms unless it is an all-weather flag. It should be displayed often, but especially on national and state holidays and special occasions.




