Household Hazardous Waste Disposal is Free

Household hazardous waste (HHW) includes corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive materials. Products such as paints, cleaners, oils, batteries, and pesticides require special handling in their disposal. E-waste, such as televisions and computers, can also be disposed of at Hazardous Waste Collection Centers. Orange County has four Collection Centers that take HHW for free. Contact your City for the facility closest to your home. Special assistance with collection, requiring door-to-door service, can be obtained by calling 714-834-4000.

Additional examples of HHW are aerosol cans, fluorescent light bulbs, needles, polishes and antifreeze. The Centers cannot accept asbestos, biological waste, explosives, tires, high-pressure cylinders and other material. Orange County residents can choose up to five items per week from a selection of partially used containers of household yard and car-care products available at the Center's Exchange Program.

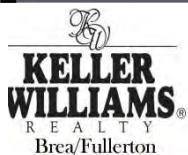
