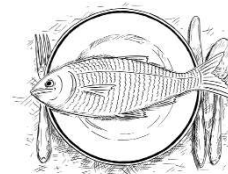
PER Fish Fry

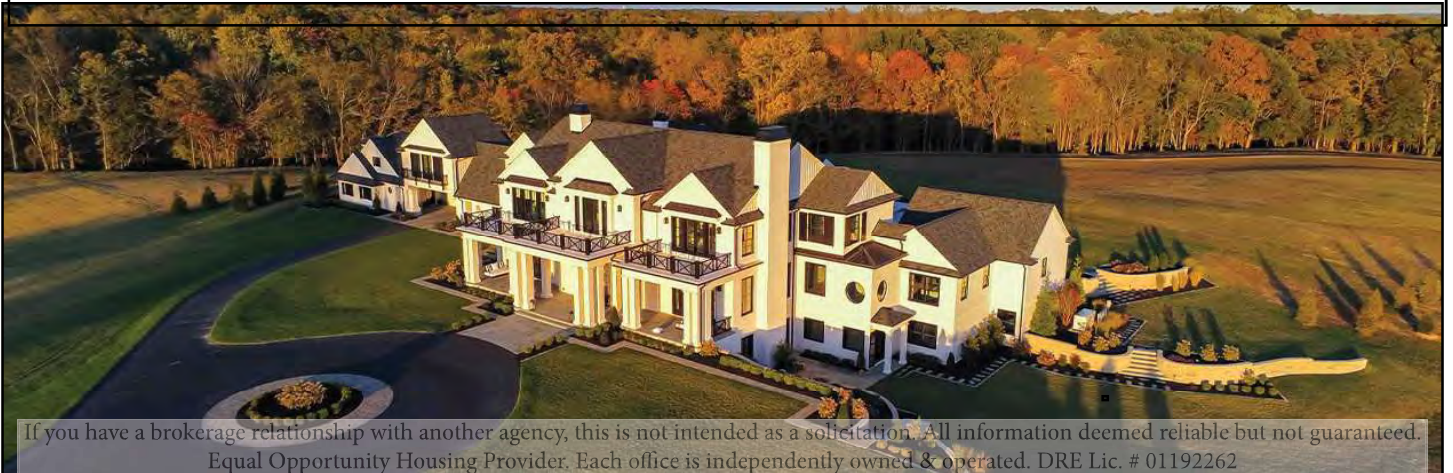

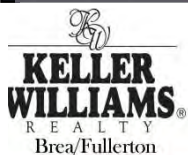
