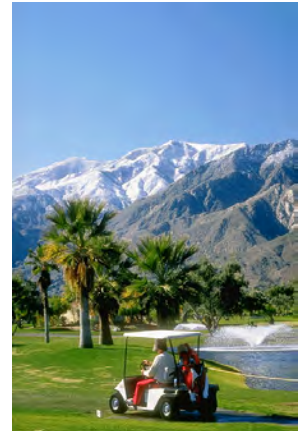
March 1st	Dos Lagos Golf Course, Corona

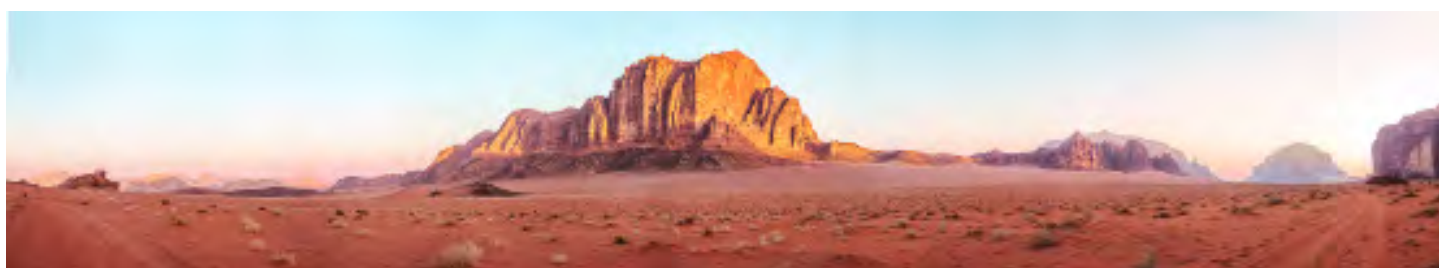
