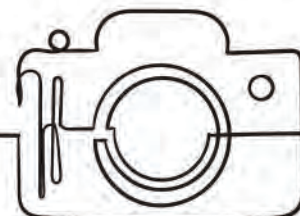
Lodge Photographers Needed
