



There are many things about Elkdom to be proud of. One of my favorites is how instrumental the Elks were in making Flag Day a national holiday.

On June 14, 1777, less than one year after Betsy Ross had received the order from General Washington to make the first flag, the Second Continental Congress passed a flag resolution stating: "Resolved,That the Flag of the United States be thirteen Stripes, alternate Red and White; that the Union be thirteen

Stars, White in a Blue field, representing a new Constellation.'

In 1907, the BPO Elks Grand Lodge designated June 14th as Flag Day. The Elks prompted President Woodrow Wilson to recognize the Order's observance of Flag Day for its patriotic expression.

But it was not until 1949 when President Harry Truman, himself a member of the Elks, made the proclamation that thereafter June 14 would be a day of national observance for the symbol of our country. Please join us this year as we celebrate Flag Day!!






