



Successful BINGO Program thrives on Volunteers



We have paid back the startup funds to the Lodge and have been working hard to get Bingo to the point where we can send money to charity on a regular basis; we are there. Our goal is to raise \$24,000 to \$40,000 dollars annually. We are realistically turning Elks Bingo into a \$2500 to \$3500 per month net donation.

This takes the efforts of many volunteers to get our players well taken care of and comfortable with our style of Bingo. Our regular players comment that they enjoy our more relaxed style of the game. We are constantly evolving and changing what we do to keep this a fun evening for our people. Many weekly players have become like family and like to see our regular volunteers.
