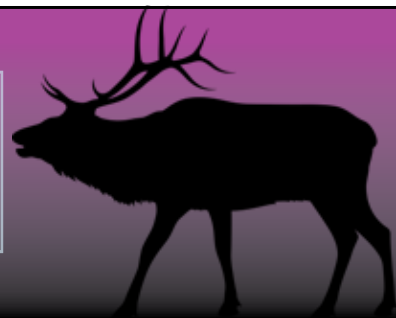

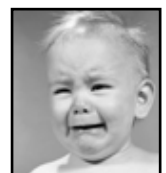

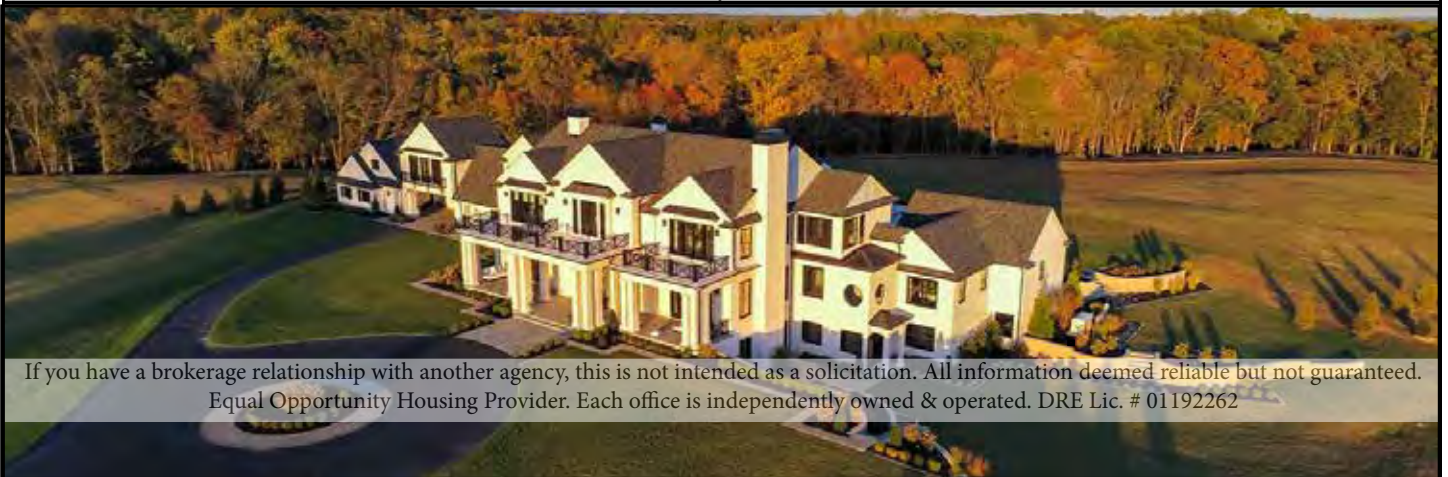


## Officer of the Quarter

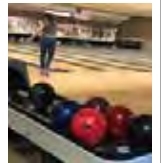
