This menth's Volunteer Spotlight shines on Amm and Mitch Hanlon, who became members of our Lodge in 2019. It all started on New Year's Day in 2018, when they took a walk ending up at the Lodge and looking in a window on the Rest side of the building. They determined that the site would be a great location for their san's wedding comption (after viewing what had been a previous party), with the reception subsequently arrunning bese in August 2018. They were not strungers to the Hills argumination, as Mitch's grandfather was an Hilt and Past Realted Ruler in Earthford, Illimais. Amm is active at St. Johnso's Catholic Church, and Mitch is the organic/clasic director at First Christian Church in Pollecton.

Their volunteer efforts began as Greeters on Tuesday nights, and mention that this was an easy way to meet many members and guests. They assist the Bingo Purple Team on Mandays helping with the sauchs. Mitch started calling bingo in 2021 and new helps weekly. Rellowing a Purple Pig Rame event where they sat at a table with Minie and Alex Name, they were asked to participate on the Lodge's Community Impart Committee. Anna wrate up the Ells. Grant application to benefit the Misple Street After School Program, and they are both new actively involved in helping Selidanity who can the totating program (and who larse partnessed with the Lodge). They assist the program twice a week as Constitutions. Anna lead a Lodge final drive to sense backparks for the students in the program through a Lodge meeting blanket drop, ultimately resulting in abtaining 48 backparks for needy Maple Street Elementary students. Both Anna and Mitch have helped at the Orange County Animal Care Services Pet Puntry, which creently created a \$3,500 grant from our Lodge. They helped last year put together Thunksgiving small bones for Pulmways of Hape, help as greaters and servers, donated a decoasted tree for the Christmas Tree Lare silent action this past December, and Mitch provided mask and cambers for the preview event. They creently agreed to coordinate the Impart Grant Committee for 2023-2021. Mitch is a serioed Call State Pulleton professor and a professional maskin. Anna is actively teaching public health at Orange Coast Cellege, Costa Mesa. We see indeed fortunate to have Anna and Mitch as members, and the volunteer time and effort that they provide our Lodge!
