Shining a Light on Our Volunteers

This month's Volunteer Spotlight shines on Anna and Mitch Hanlon, who became members of our Lodge in 2019. It all started on New Year's Day in 2018, when they took a walk ending up at the Lodge and looking in a window on the East side of the building. They determined that the site would be a great location for their son's wedding reception (after viewing what had been a previous party), with the reception subsequently occurring here in August 2018. They were not strangers to the Elks organization, as Mitch's grandfather was an Elk and Past Exalted Ruler in Rockford, Illinois. Anna is active at St. Juliana's Catholic Church, and Mitch is the organist/chair director at First Christian Church in Fullerton.

Their volunteer efforts began as Greeters on Tuesday nights, and mention that this was an easy way to meet many members and guests. They assist the Purple Pig Team on Mondays helping with the snacks. Mitch started calling kinglys in 2021 and now helps weekly. Following a Purple Pig Race event where they sat at a table with Marie and Alex Nunez, they were asked to participate on the Lodge's Community Impact Committee. Anna wrote up the Elks Grant application to benefit the Maple Street After School Program, and they are both now actively involved in helping Solidarity who run the tutoring program (and who have partnered with the Lodge). They assist the program twice a week as Coordinators. Anna led a Lodge fund drive to secure backpacks for the students in the program through a Lodge meeting blanket drive, ultimately resulting in obtaining 48 backpacks for needy Maple Street Elementary students. Both Anna and Mitch have helped at the Orange County Animal Care Services Pet Pantry, which recently received a \$3,500 grant from our Lodge. They helped last year put together Thanksgiving meal boxes for Pathways of Hope, help as greeters and servers, donated a decorated tree for the Christmas Tree Lane silent auction this past December, and Mitch provided music and carolers for the preview event. They recently agreed to coordinate the Impact Grant Committee for 2023-2023. Mitch is a retired Cal State Fullerton professor and a professional musician. Anna is actively teaching public health at Orange Coast College, Costa Mesa. We are indeed fortunate to have Anna and Mitch as members, and the volunteer time and effort that they provide our Lodge!

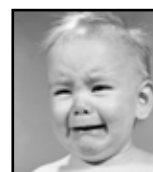
