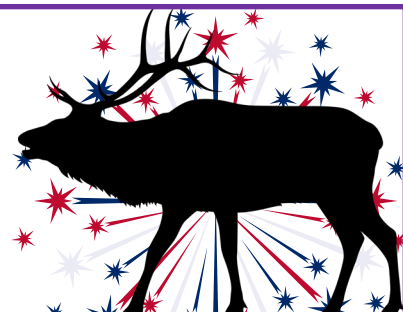

Be charitable to ALL mankind!

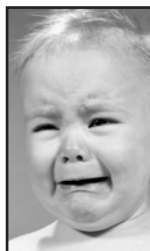

ALLEN BISBEE WAS BORN AND RAISED IN ANAHEIM, CALIFORNIA. AFTER GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL ALLEN DECIDED TO ENROLL IN THE MORTUARY SCIENCE PROGRAM AT CYPRESS COLLEGE. UPON COMPLETION OF HIS MORTUARY SCIENCE EDUCATION, ALLEN WOULD BEGIN WHAT IS NOW A 37 YEAR, AND COUNTING, FUNERAL SERVICE CAREER.



SEVERAL YEARS LATER DURING AN EVENING OF KARAOKE ALLEN WAS INTRODUCED TO MARIA, AND JUST A FEW MONTHS LATER THEY STARTED DATING. 

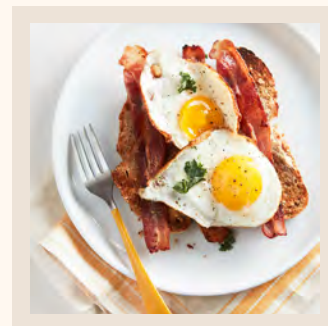
