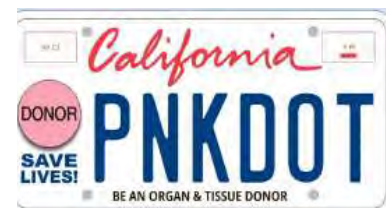

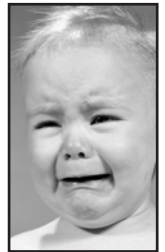

He was born with an extremely rare brain disease called Glucose Transmitter Type 1 Deficiency Syndrome. It is a rare metabolic disorder that affects the brain. He is missing the gene that breaks down

carbohydrates. Common symptoms are seizures, abnormal movements of the head, eyes & body, slurred speech and cognitive disorders. This disease is successfully treated with a ketogenic diet. For Dylan this means a strict diet of no carbohydrates and high fat. He gets all his energy from fats. Dylan (nicknamed DJ) is a happy young man with limited vocabulary. He loves music, dancing,

swimming, bowling, baseball, soccer and going to church.

The Elks gave Dylan an Amazon giftcard so he can replace his aging laptop. Exalted Ruler Bill Swaim presented Dylan with his ER Pin. Darren Baker presented Dylan's Mother, June with flowers and a special medal for Dylan.
