



- Blood products are perishable and cannot be manufactured; they can only come from volunteer donors.
- 16-year-old students are eligible to donate blood with a signed parental consent.
- Cancer patients use nearly one quarter of the blood supply – more than patients fighting any other disease.
- A single car accident victim can require as many as 100 pints of blood.
- A diverse blood supply is important! A patient is more likely to find a compatible blood match from a donor of the same race or a similar ethnic group.

October · November · December 2025

In October, we kicked off the fall season by hosting our **second Craft Kit Day** in partnership with *Help Heal Veterans*, assembling luggage tags for hospitalized and recovering veterans. Even more members joined in this time — and together we almost **doubled our output**, completing **3,700+ luggage tags** in just over two hours! The room buzzed with teamwork and enthusiasm as everyone worked hard to support our veterans — a shining example of what makes our Lodge so special.

Later in the month, we proudly hosted our **Baked Potato Extravaganza Bar** — a fun and heartwarming night of food and fellowship! Members and guests piled their potatoes high with toppings galore, served with smiles and pride by our veteran volunteers. Every dollar raised helps support programs that give back to those who've served our nation. It was a *night filled with laughter, good food, and gratitude — because Elks Care, and Elks Share!*

Our **Veterans Day celebration, in November**, was truly a day to remember! The Lodge was filled with music, camaraderie, and the irresistible aroma of crispy fried chicken with all the fixings.

We stood proudly together to honor the men and women who have worn our nation's uniform. *A special thank-you to Mr. James Hyland of Nothing Bundt Cake for donating desserts "to die for" — the perfect sweet finish to a heartfelt celebration!* A **big thanks to all our veterans** who took the time to join us — your presence brings meaning to everything we do.

In November, we also proudly partnered with the **Huntington Beach Elks Lodge** for their *Adopt-A-Ship* program supporting the **USS Tripoli**. Together, we delivered items from the sailor's "wish lists," providing small comforts that mean so much to those serving far from home. These gestures remind our service members that they are never forgotten — not by their country, and certainly not by the Elks.

The holiday spirit is shining bright! Our committee once again decorated the *Veterans Christmas Tree* for **Christmas Tree Lane**. This year's theme was "**Freedom Lights the Tree**", filling the Lodge with patriotic pride and heartfelt tribute.

We joined **Wreaths Across America**, placing wreaths on the graves of our heroes at the *Memorial Garden in Brea* on December 13th. Thanks to the success of our Baked Potato fundraiser, **we proudly sponsored 25 wreaths this year** — a beautiful reminder that freedom is never free.

December also brought a special giving opportunity: raising funds for **Bikes4Marines & Navy**, providing bicycles for children whose parents are deployed. Our original goal was 10 bikes — but thanks to the overwhelming generosity of our members, we tripled that goal, delivering money for 31 brand-new bikes to make these military kids' holidays brighter!

Then in mid-December, we cooked and delivered **15 pizzas and a fresh Caesar salad** to the *Placentia Veterans Village*, sharing warmth, food, and holiday cheer with those who served.




