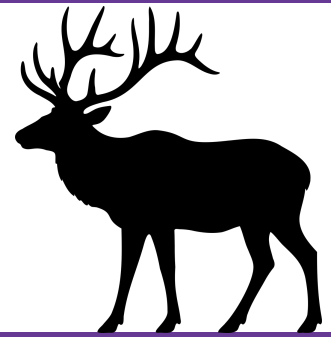

Ricardo is non verbal and uses an eye gaze computer communication device to let people know what he needs and what makes him happy. He has many medical challenges, including a movement disorder, epilepsy, and orthopedic issues.

Ricardo is happy and eager to participate in everything. He especially loves baseball and he would watch baseball all day if he was allowed to.

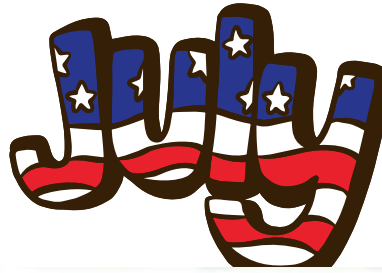
