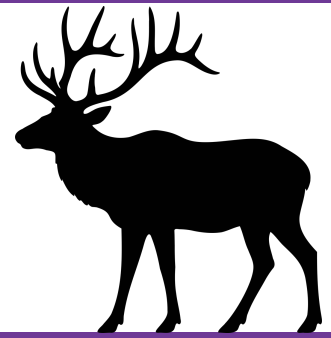

Felix's cousin, Gary, passed away from heart complications. Prayers for his Aunt Delores, who outlived two of her children.

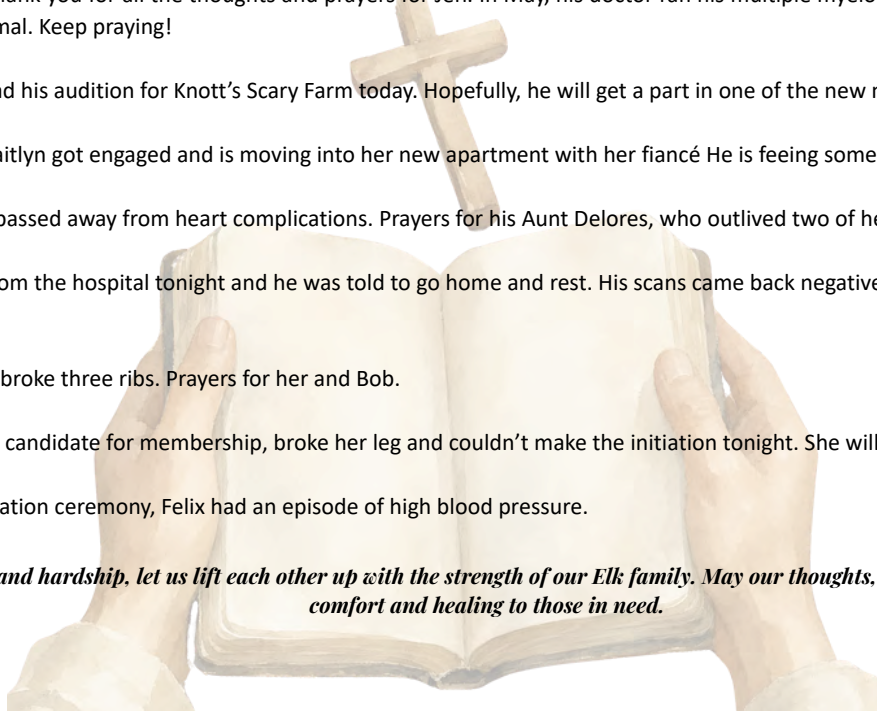
Felix was released from the hospital tonight and he was told to go home and rest. His scans came back negative. Violet read a letter of thanks from Felix.
